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As the Substitute Teacher, you will be supporting a multi-age Montessori classroom of children in either a Toddler, Primary, Jr. Elementary, or Sr. Elementary class. You will be responsible for maintaining a safe and caring learning environment and supporting the implementation of the Montessori core program in partnership with one or two other teachers.

Specific responsibilities

- Supports the establishment of a safe and caring learning environment that is organized and engaging
- Partners effectively with other Lead or Assistant Teacher(s) to ensure students are learning and achieving at high levels
- Helps maintain a powerful classroom culture where children have high expectations of themselves and for others, are self-motivated and self-directed, have pride in and care about themselves and their community, and where children value and love learning
- Demonstrates knowledge of and support for Jarrow Montessori's mission, vision, value statements, standards, policies and procedures, operating instructions, confidentiality standards, and the code of ethical behavior.
